Dear Parents and Guardians,

Soon your child will have the opportunity to attend Camp Colton – Project LIFE (Life In the Flagstaff Environment). Attached is information that explains the program, the schedule, what to bring, and other information. Additionally, there are forms included in this packet you will need to complete and send with your child's teacher to Camp.

A summary of the forms that must accompany your child's visit to Camp Colton are:

**Student Permission/Consent Form:** This permission form and publicity release needs to be completed with signatures and returned along with all other necessary paperwork to your child's teacher the week prior to attending Camp.

**Medication Procedure/Student Health Information:** This is a two-sided form. You must complete this form if your child requires **any** over-the-counter or prescription medication during their stay at camp. This is important because no over-the-counter medication, including Tylenol or Ibuprofen, is stocked at camp, these medications must be provided by parents/guardians.

The back of this form is the **Student Health Information and Consent for Emergency Care**. Please list any allergies, specific health conditions, and/or special needs for your child during their stay at Camp Colton.

Please make sure both sides of this form are complete and accurate.

These forms require parent or guardian signatures in 3 separate places.

**Please be sure all the above forms are completed, signed and returned to your child's teacher the Wednesday prior to your child's attendance at Camp.**

On the other side of this letter is the **Student Checklist** of what to bring to camp and what not to bring to camp along with a sample schedule of what their week at camp will be like.
