Renaissance Magnet Middle School is an exceptional educational organization in the Flagstaff Unified School District. Core curriculum is based on the State Standards. The magnet focus areas are available in Visual Arts, Drama, Dance, Technology, and Advanced Science.

The RMMS core and magnet teachers strive to integrate and combine curriculum. Teachers work closely together with a team wide focus upon the academic success of each student.

We are very proud of our school. Students that return to visit attest to the education they received while here. They often say they feel more equipped to tackle high school and higher education because of their experience with us.

As you make your choice for school enrollment, consider what RMMS has to offer. Call the office to receive your application packet. Registration and enrollment is ongoing but limited to 125 students.

RMMS Magnet Choices

Theater provides comprehensive theater experience. The class has a performance emphasis; students also study acting theory and terminology. Students work with costuming and make-up and write character sketches and critiques. Performances are both group and individual. No prior performance experience is required, but students must be highly motivated to study theater. Students need to be able to work independently to prepare both individual and group performances.



Computer Technology offers development of technical skills, problem solving and critical thinking, historical perspectives of technology, and current applications and developments of technology and the role it plays in the modern world. Students will emerge with sound keyboarding skills, knowledge of word processing, spreadsheet and database applications, and will be adept in the utilization of the Internet as a resource tool.

Art is an intensive studio-based art experience for the serious art student. Extended individual and group projects lasting from two weeks to two months will engage students in the exploration of 2D and 3D materials, creative problem solving, technical skills and artistic growth. Students will be encouraged to propose, develop and evaluate highly individualized projects based on common themes or artistic problems that will often reflect research in core subjects.



Dance is a performing arts class that emphasizes a variety of dance styles. Students learn many different dances, including folk, swing, ballet, modern, country, interpretive and others. Students will conduct live individual and group performances to demonstrate their abilities. Students who enjoy physical activity, along with individual and group performance, should consider this magnet.

Advanced Science Applications

Students will study areas of scientific interest and take a more in-depth look at topics covered in regular middle school science program. Aeronautics, geology, physics and the classification of plants and animals are explored. With full enrollment at RMMS (100+ students) Advanced Science is a full year magnet. Low enrollment may create a 50/50 split of the school year between Advanced Science and Technology magnet classes.
