Renaissance Magnet Middle School (RMMS) was established to allow middle school students an opportunity to explore a core curriculum with a focus on a magnet emphasis area. Magnet classes include: Dance, Visual Art, Theatre Arts, Computer Technology, and Advanced Science. The “core” teaching team instructs classes in science, math, social studies and English. Additional classroom experiences are provided through the RMMS ASSURE program where explorations in languages, writing/journalism, and fitness awareness take place.

The RMMS core and magnet teachers strive to integrate and combine curriculum and work closely together to get to know each RMMS student extremely well. The team focuses on the academic success of each student. Factors to consider when applying to RMMS:

- RMMS is a magnet school. Students should have a significant interest in their magnet choice.
- RMMS core curriculum follows the state academic standards and requirements for middle school students in grades 7 and 8.
- School starts at 9:20 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m.
- Core class periods are 90 minutes and follow an alternating-day schedule.
- Math 7/8, pre-algebra, algebra and geometry are math courses offered at RMMS. Please note that a mathematics placement test will be administered to all RMMS students to determine proper math placement.
- Individual Education Plans RMMS provides a total “inclusion” educational setting where students with special needs receive additional academic assistance from an inclusion assistant. Although every effort is made to accommodate all students, those students with an Individual Education Plan indicating a “Resource” setting may find it difficult to be successful at RMMS.

It is important to understand how your child feels about school. Begin by asking a few questions about your child’s perceptions and attitudes about RMMS. Some questions might be:

- What would be your magnet emphasis? (Students who want more exposure to their existing interest area should choose that area as their magnet.)
- What is your favorite/least favorite subject, and why?
- What school will your friends attend?

Renaissance Magnet Middle School welcomes visits and inquiries. Magnet classes meet from 2:50 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the school year. Appointments can be scheduled through the Mount Elden Middle School office at 773-8250. School handbooks, brochures, and class scheduling guides are available in the counseling office.
