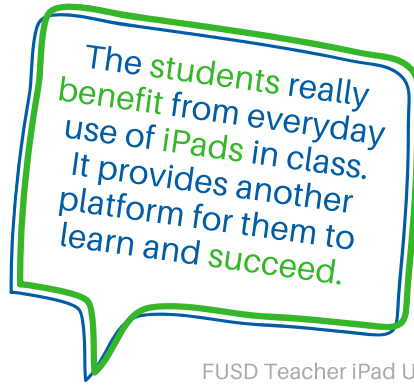
## Shared Student Devices

FUSD Teacher iPad Usage Survey 17-18

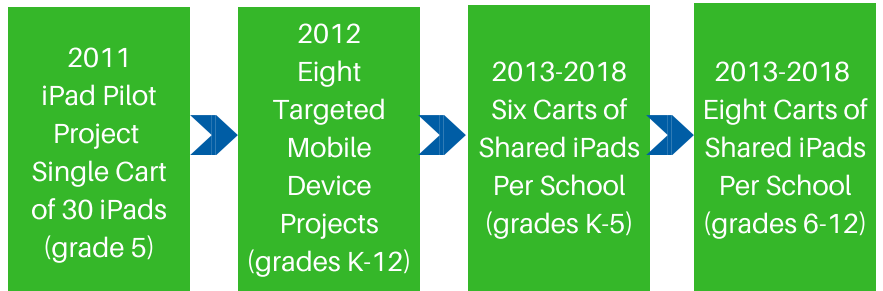
