What is a School Tax Credit?

Donations to public schools have always been tax deductible. A **tax deduction** allows you to subtract the contribution amount from your taxable income. If you work in Arizona and pay state taxes, the **tax credit** will save you dollar for dollar on the amount of taxes you owe.

If you have donated to extracurricular activities at a public school any time since January 1, you may already have saved up to \$400 for married couples filing jointly or \$200 for individual taxpayers on your state income taxes.

The tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers whether or not you have children in the public schools or whether or not you live within Flagstaff Unified School District #1.

You help kids. It costs you nothing.

Extracurricular activities such as sports, band, speech and debate, or field trips generally cannot be fully funded by school district revenues and depend on fees from students. Arizona law allows taxpayers a credit of up to \$400 for married couples filing jointly or \$200 for individuals if they contribute to extracurricular activities in public schools supported by fees.

It's so easy!

To support any of the programs listed on the response card in this brochure, write a check to the school or schools of your choice. Make a note in the memo line of your check which extra-curricular activity you wish to support. Send your check to the school or the district office with the Response Card. You may also donate with a credit card by going to www.fusd1.org or calling the District at (928) 527-6041.

You will be provided a receipt verifying that you have contributed to an eligible activity. Next year, claim your tax credit on your State Income Tax Return. For more information go to <http://www.azdor.gov/TaxCredits/SchoolTaxCreditsforIndividuals.aspx>
