
MITIGATION STRATEGIES

2021-2022 School Year



Social Distancing

Observe a distance of at least three (3) feet apart from one another.
Greater distance is encouraged where feasible.



School Closures

The FUSD COVID Support Team will work with the local health department to determine school closures due to COVID-19 outbreaks.



Cleaning & Disinfecting

Daily cleaning and disinfecting occurs for all high touch surfaces and deep cleaning occurs as needed in the event of a COVID exposure.



Athletics

Arizona Interscholastic Association guidelines will be followed. FUSD may limit event spectators as needed.



Face Masks

Face masks are required for all individuals inside our buildings and while on the bus, regardless of vaccine status.



Large Group Gatherings

Large indoor gatherings and schoolwide assemblies are not recommended. Outdoor activities are highly encouraged instead.



Distance Learning

Flagstaff Online Academy (K-4) and Northern Arizona Distance Learning (5-12) are available for families who prefer distance learning.



Contact Tracing & Quarantine

Contact tracing will occur in the event of a positive COVID test. Indirect and direct contacts will be notified with procedures and quarantine guidelines.



Classroom Materials

Students are recommended to have individual materials. Shared materials may be used with hand hygiene and cleaning/disinfecting.



Hand Hygiene

Students and staff are asked to wash their hands with soap and water throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will also be available as needed.



Visitors

Visitors will be limited to only essential individuals. Approved visitors will undergo a temperature screening and building sign-in.
