"Joy enjoys books! I think I am done looking. Will you please help me pick a book?"

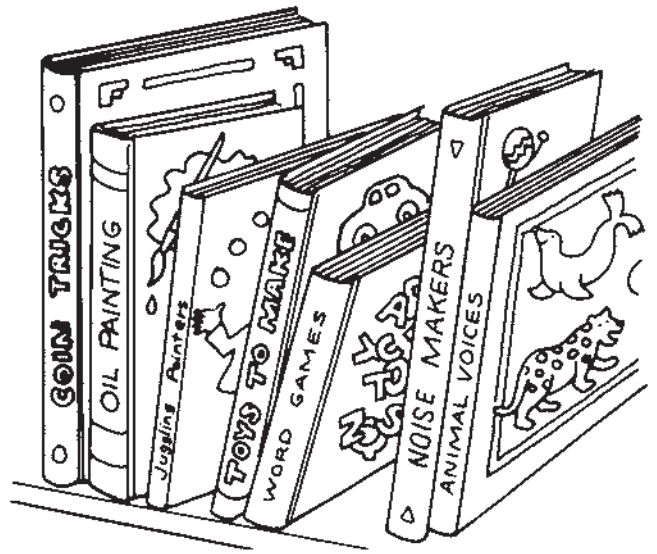


"How about sweets?"

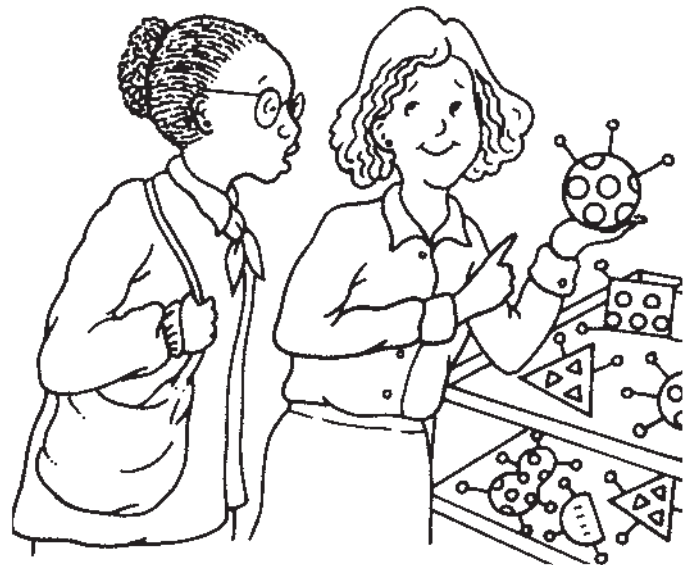
"These are the best books,"
