<p><b>Music:</b> Draw a doodle using musical symbols. Here's an example:</p> 	<p><b>Art:</b> Water fun! Draw the best water park slides that you can imagine. Include yourself on the slide.</p>	<p><b>Library:</b> Look at the copyright date on the back side of the Title page. Look for a book to read that is at least 5 years old.</p>	<p><b>STEM:</b> Build a mini car using things around your house. Measure how far it rolls.</p>	<p><b>PE:</b> Flamingo stretch for 30 seconds on both legs Hold one leg up while balancing on the other</p>
<p><b>STEM:</b> Find something that can't stand on its own by itself (foil, plastic wrap). Find ways to make it stand on its own and measure how tall it got.</p>	<p><b>PE:</b> Try to touch your toes for 30 seconds standing up. See if you can do it two times in a row.</p>	<p><b>Music:</b> Find 3 different versions of your favorite song. What are the differences and which do you like better?</p>	<p><b>Art:</b> Ice cream you scream! Draw an ice cream sundae with your favorite toppings.</p>	<p><b>Library:</b> Act out a part of a story that you have just read. See if anyone can guess what you are acting out.</p>
<p><b>Art:</b> You're an author and illustrator! Take a paper, fold it or cut it into the pages of a small book. Create characters and text. Include speech and thought bubbles. Add a setting, too.</p>	<p><b>Library:</b> Call a friend and ask them to suggest a book for you to read.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Free Space</b></p> 	<p><b>PE:</b> Reach as high as you can for the sky with both hands and hold for a whole minute</p>	<p><b>Music:</b> Find and listen to a song with a person's name in the title</p>
<p><b>PE:</b> Sit down and try to touch your toes for 30 seconds. Legs straight out in front of you. Try doing this one twice in a row!</p>	<p><b>Music:</b> Pretend you are a conductor leading an orchestra. Turn on music and pretend to lead an orchestra.</p>	<p><b>Art:</b> Sculpture! So how about gathering some objects from around the house (with permission) and joining them together (tape, glue, string, gravity) to make a sculpture!</p>	<p><b>Library:</b> Try a book that is challenging.</p>	<p><b>STEM:</b> Go outside and find a plant with flowers. Count how many petals it has. Compare the number of petals with another plant.</p>
<p><b>Library:</b> Call a friend and tell them about the book you just read.</p>	<p><b>STEM:</b> Build a container for popped popcorn. Pop the popcorn and see if you guessed the correct size for the amount you popped.</p>	<p><b>PE:</b> Spread your feet past your shoulders and try to touch the ground for 30 seconds. Try doing this twice in a row</p>	<p><b>Music:</b> Find and listen to a song with an animal in the title</p>	<p><b>Art:</b> My favorite lesson! Try to recreate your favorite art lesson from this year. Add any changes that you are inspired by!</p>
