<p>Music: Find and listen to a duet (two people singing at the same time) Do they make the song better or would you prefer the song with only one singer?</p>	<p>Art: Listen to your favorite song/music. Close your eyes. Imagine what the music looks like. Draw it!</p>	<p>Library: Ask a family member to read you their favorite book.</p>	<p>STEM: Find four things in your home that are alive.</p>	<p>PE: Play your favorite PE activity with your family.</p>
<p>STEM: Is it level? Use a marble or ball to decide if a flat surface is level. Try it on a table top or your uncarpeted floor. Does it roll far? Why?</p>	<p>PE: Take turns with your family choosing different exercises to do together.</p>	<p>Music: Pick an instrument in your favorite song. "Air play" that instrument along with your song.</p>	<p>Art: Shape search! Look around your house. Read them a story. Answer: A Waaaaaa-ter-melon. Now create a joke of your own and share it with someone.</p>	<p>STEM: Magnetic attraction. What will a magnet stick to? Use a magnet on objects around your house to find out.</p>
<p>Library: Read a joke book with a family member, then practice the jokes on a family member.</p>	<p>STEM: Look at a flower. Can you name the parts? Remember that there is also a part under the ground.</p>	<p>PE: Invent a game and try it out.</p>	<p>Music: Put on some music and have a dance battle with a family member or a friend. What song did you dance to and who danced better?</p>	<p>Art: Draw a picture with your eyes closed. Does it look like the object you imagined?</p>
