Remember that the object farthest from you will be placed higher up on your paper to show distance.</p>	<p>Library: Act out a scene from one of the chapters from the book you are reading.</p>	<p>STEM: Is it level? Use a marble or ball to decide if a flat surface is level. Try it on a table top or your uncarpeted floor. Does it roll far? Why?</p>	<p>PE: Invent a game and try it out.</p>
<p>STEM: Remember the cup song? Design your own song.</p>	<p>PE: Find a family member and do jumping jacks together. How many can you do?</p>	<p>Music: Think of a song that would match each of these emotions: happiness, sadness, anger, and fear</p>	<p>Art: Mickey Mouse and Sponge Bob Morph!! Look up and listen to some music from that country.</p>

With a family member or friend, take turns naming a musical word or style starting with each letter of the alphabet. Loser gets stumped!</p>	<p>Art: Get a grip!! Draw, write, or color with your opposite hand.</p>	<p>Library: Call a friend and tell them what Genre you tend to read most often. Ask your friend what Genre they look for when selecting a book.</p>	<p>STEM: Magnetic attraction. What will a magnet stick to? Use a magnet on objects around your house to find out.</p>
<p>Library: Write a short story about what you've done while you have been staying home and save it in a safe place.</p>	<p>STEM: Stand outside. Listen closely. How many different noises can you hear? Are they near or far? Which are loudest? Why?</p>	<p>PE: Play your favorite PE activity with your family</p>	<p>Music: Put on some music and have a dance battle with a family member or a friend. What song did you dance to and who danced better?</p>	<p>Art: Sunglasses time! Design a pair of sunglasses. Draw large. Use your wildest imagination, e.g., outer space glasses, under the sea glasses, firefighter glasses, etc.</p>
