<p>Music: Teach a family member your favorite song</p>	<p>Art: Draw a futuristic building. Include a foreground, middle ground, and background (things in front of the building, then the building, and things behind the building.)</p>	<p>Library: Read a book to whoever is cooking dinner tonight.</p>	<p>STEM: Secret Code! Create your own secret message. Use symbols instead of letters. Ask a sibling or your parents to figure out your code.</p>	<p>PE: Push up position pick up ball w/one hand put under chin & grab with other hand. 20 times</p>
<p>STEM: Create a bar graph with five columns and seven rows. Starting at the bottom, number the rows by 10's: 10, 20, 30, etc. Now label the columns Monday, Tuesday, etc. Record the high or low temperatures each day this week. Look for a trend. Is the temperature getting higher or lower? Is there no trend?</p>	<p>PE: Go for a walk with family member</p>	<p>Music: Listen to a song that is more than 100 years old, then tell someone what you thought about it (examples: Carnival of the Animals, Ode to Joy, Firebird)</p>	<p>Art: Invent an animal. Does it have wings? Claws? Stripes? A tail? What does it eat? Where does it live? Draw it! Include its habitat.</p>	<p>Library: On a blank piece of paper, fold in 1/4ths, Write on each page what you have done today. Now draw pictures to go with your story. Remember to give your "BOOK" a title.</p>
<p>Art: How will I get there? Ever think about what your first vehicle will look like? Will it be a car, truck, jet? Monster truck?! How big or small? Tires or water wings? Where will it take you? Draw your dream vehicle!</p>	<p>Library: Trade books with your sibling or Parent for 1 chapter.</p>	<p>Free Space</p> 	<p>PE: Dribble a ball with your feet around your yard</p>	<p>Music: Listen to a song that is less than 50 years old, then tell someone what you thought about it (examples: Ella Fitzgerald, Raffi, Steve Reich)</p>
<p>PE: Do 30 mountain climbers.</p>	<p>Music: Find 2 objects that sound different when struck, then play with a song on a steady beat. Make sure to change between them often.</p>	<p>Art: Yikes, I have no shoes!! Imagine that you have to invent shoes with only items that you have in your house. Try making shoes! Ask permission before using things in the house.</p>	<p>Library: On a blank piece of paper, fold in 1/4ths, Write on each page what you have done today. Now draw pictures to go with your story. Remember to give your "BOOK" a title.</p>	<p>STEM: Look at the night sky each night this week. Do you see the moon? Keep a journal showing each night's moon. Look for a pattern. Is it getting bigger or smaller? Make a prediction for what the next night's moon will look like.</p>
<p>Library: On a blank piece of paper, fold in 1/4ths, Write on each page what you have done today. Now draw pictures to go with your story. Remember to give your "BOOK" a title.</p>	<p>STEM: With permission from your parents, try making a tower of pillows. See how high you can stack them. Make changes in your stack to go even higher!</p>	<p>PE: Dance to your favorite song.</p>	<p>Music: Learn a handwashing dance routine</p>	<p>Art: Try out a drawing on this link: https://www.artforkidshub.com/</p>
