STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

The APEX Academy at MEMS offers a rigorous, comprehensive and well-rounded program to a select group of academically talented students in the middle school community. The APEX Academy instructional team at MEMS is dedicated to ensuring the continued excellence and integrity of this program. The expectation is that students and parents will support the academic goals and policies of the program in which their students are involved.

The instructors in the APEX Academy program, in cooperation with the administration at MEMS, have the right to determine student consequences due to serious breaches of integrity, lapses in attendance, or any other issues that affect the overall quality of the program and the success of individual students in the APEX Academy program.

Students in the APEX Academy at MEMS are required to maintain the following standards and practices:

- Keep a 3.0 GPA, or a score of a proficient (3 or 4) if standards-based grading is used, in all core academic classes (English, Social Studies, Science and Math). Each student's progress will be reviewed at the end of each reporting period. Students with unsatisfactory progress will be given time (to the next reporting period) to improve their GPA/proficiency to the required standards. APEX classes are NOT weighted.
- Show acceptable behavior in class and at all MEMS activities. Each disciplinary action or referral will be
 reviewed by the APEX Academy instructional team and consequences will be determined according to the
 frequency and type of incident referred.
- Maintain consistent and timely attendance in classes. APEX Academy students who lose credit in a course due to violation of the MEMS attendance policy will be removed from the academy.
- **Submit original and properly cited work and assignments.** Each student shall submit work free of plagiarism from other sources, including but not exclusive to homework, writing assignments, textbook and the Internet. Students must submit work that is the result of their own efforts and not the efforts of other persons.

Consequences, up to and including removal from the APEX Academy, will be determined by the APEX Academy instructors in conjunction with the administration at MEMS.
