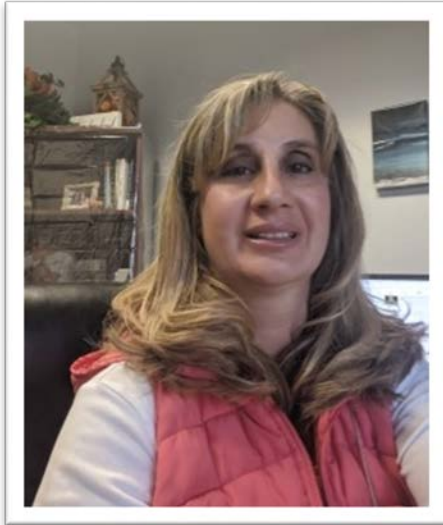


Linda Harbottle, M.Ed.
