Guess what class of 2021? Senior Parking is finally here! Listed below are some simple rules and guidelines that we must follow in order to keep senior parking. Get yours early on registration, we will sell out!

- **Spots will be sold on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning at Senior Registration.** Spots will be sold until we sell out.
- Park only in YOUR spot.
- Your hanging parking permit with the number corresponding to your parking spot is required at all times.
- Spots will be checked regularly by Student Council members during Student Council class.
- If a problem occurs, you will contact the Student Council first by filling out the “Someone Parked In My Spot” form and turning it in to room 204. Forms are located in room 204.
- Respect others’ property. Do not touch anyone’s vehicle or damage it in any way.
- Vandalism of any kind will be NOT tolerated.
- If any violent action or vandalism takes place, consequences will include criminal charges.
- You may ONLY paint your parking spot without the square. Adding anything inappropriate to the parking spot could result in additional charges and or revocation of your senior parking privilege without a refund.
- During after school hours your spot is open to anyone.
- Spots are non-refundable.
- The cost is \$10.

Please keep in mind that senior parking is a privilege that can be taken away at any time per CHS Administration.
