GRADUATION CONTRACT (distributed to students in March 2023)

Congratulations to the 100th year of FHS graduates! Commencement will be **May 26th, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. in the NAU Walkup Skydome**. This ceremony is designed to honor you for completing all of the graduation requirements established by the State of Arizona and the Flagstaff Unified School District Governing Board of Education. Participation in the ceremony is contingent upon your successful completion of the required credits and adherence to school regulation for behavior and attendance. Please make every effort to ensure that you are: making satisfactory progress towards your graduation requirements that maintain a proper learning environment and show respect for all school activities, policies, and rules.

There are very few moments in life that one participates in a ceremony of this magnitude. This should be a very special occasion for you as a member of the class of 2023, as well as the staff of Flagstaff High School. You are following a rich tradition established by Flagstaff High School's first graduating class in 1923, one of tradition, dignity, and pride. To help us continue that tradition, the following must be agreed upon by each senior and his or her parent or guardian.

1. I will attend all practices scheduled for the graduation ceremony: I agree to adjust my personal obligations to meet the practice schedule. **The graduation practice is Thursday, May 25 at 1:30**
2. I agree to wear the cap and gown selected for the ceremony. You may decorate your caps with a cultural, academic, or positive message that is school appropriate and will need to be approved in advance.
3. I agree to conform to the following dress code for the ceremony: **Graduates should be dressed in semi-formal &/or cultural attire**; jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, combat boots, or beach sandals are inappropriate. If a graduate is having difficulty attaining the proper attire for the ceremony, please contact an administrator for assistance.
4. I will NOT carry anything into the dome that will disrupt the ceremony. I agree to be courteous during the entire ceremony and refrain from any activity that is disruptive, distractive, or dangerous. I further agree to leave the ceremony when asked to do so if I fail to adhere to these guidelines. I understand that if I violate this, I will not receive my diploma until I complete up to 30 hours of community service for Flagstaff high School under the supervision of the administration.
5. I agree to pay all debts to Flagstaff High School and turn in all materials, iPads, and textbooks prior to participating in the graduation ceremony.
6. I understand that if I violate any school rules that necessitate suspension from school any time during the school year, I am subject to removal from any and all school activities including the graduation ceremony.
7. I understand that participation in the graduation ceremony is not required to receive my high school diploma.
8. All online coursework and a transcript to the registrar (tcannon@fUSD1.org) must be completed by May 15, 2023.
