Registration: High School Registration (for fall 2024 classes) will begin on Friday March 1st and will go through the following week. Please review paperwork with your student and discuss course planning. Students should be reaching out to current teachers for class recommendations.

Next Steps Webinar: On March 20th from 6:00-7:30 pm, FHS will be joined by a number of universities, community colleges and scholarship organizations to give information about next steps after making your admission decisions. The webinar link will be sent out via parent/studentvue and on the FHS website.

ECAP lessons: Counselors are wrapping up their Spring ECAP lessons. Topics discussed include: four year plans, learning styles, resume building. Please talk with your student about the Major Clarity Program.

Scholarships: Scholarship opportunities are being sent out in your studentvue/parentvue messages. There is also a list of national and local scholarships in the Major Clarity Platform under "financial resources". Many schools also have scholarships available

FAFSA Support: The updated FAFSA is open! Completing this application gives students access to a number of different types of financial assistance for college. College Visits: NAU will be visiting FHS on Friday, March 29th during Lunch in the CCR room (across from commons). No need to sign up-just show up!
