Dear FHS Parents and Students,

You are receiving this letter because your student is currently taking a course or multiple courses that have been articulated with the community college. The Flagstaff High School teacher, who is instructing this class, has all of the required certifications and is teaching the expected outcomes of the college.

Dual Enrollment is an option that Flagstaff High School is pleased to be able to offer for our students, but it is <u>not</u> compulsory. The cost for taking the academic core classes is \$25.00 per credit hour. (Please see the chart listed below for the cost totals.) These same courses would cost approximately \$311.00 to \$508.00 at CCC, plus the cost of textbooks. If you would like your student to receive dual enrollment credit, payment is due by February 13th, 2015 at 3pm. You may pay by cash, check or credit card in the FHS Bookstore. You can even call the bookstore and Mrs. Johnston will take your payment over the phone. (Her phone number is: 928-773-8144.) All of the CTE (Career and Technical Education) courses are <u>free</u>, as long as your student completes the entire registration packet and earns the grade of a C or better. (*If the grade in a CTE class drops below a C, the teacher has the right to withdraw the student.*)

If your student is considering an Arizona University as their post secondary option, then the credits are transferrable. You may check at: www.aztransfer.com for more information on how exactly the credits transfer. If your student is considering an out of state college or university, they can check with admissions representatives from the specific out of state colleges to determine if dual enrollment credits will be accepted.

FHS faculty and counseling staff members are <u>not</u> discouraging students from taking the Advanced Placement exams. If it is affordable, we actually recommend that the student participate in both the AP exam process as well as Dual Enrollment as this will provide students with the best of both academic possibilities.
