## **Application for Early Graduation**

This form and letter of graduation intent are due no later than May 15<sup>th</sup> the year before desired graduation.

## **Important Deadlines and Information**

- Students must still meet graduation requirements as mandated by the state of Arizona (this is typically Gov./Econ., Eng. 12 A/B, and 1.0 math credit).
- Credits completed outside of FUSD that are required for graduation need to be provided to FHS on an official transcript no later than December 15<sup>th</sup> or May 15<sup>th</sup>, depending on which semester you are planning on graduating. If you miss this deadline, you must enroll in at least four FHS courses the following semester to be considered a full-time FHS student and be eligible to receive an FHS diploma.

## Student must be self-motivated to complete these credits

- Meet with your school counselor to discuss options and how credits will be earned.
- Meet with an administrator to discuss expectations and requirements for graduating early.
- Turn in this application, including necessary signatures, and a letter detailing your plans for early graduation to your school counselor by May 15<sup>th</sup> the year before desired graduation.

NOTE! Students and parents understand that additional post-secondary assistance is also self-motivated as the student will forgo senior level ECAP lessons that include assistance for FAFSA, scholarship, and college applications. Students must independently meet with their counselor for ECAP guidance.
