REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Summer School 2021 is for FUSD STUDENTS ONLY and is TUITION FREE. In-Person Learning.

Due to COVID and FUSD Guidelines all students and staff must wear a mask while in class, restrooms and passing in the hallways. The masks can be removed when eating breakfast or lunch in the commons area, sitting with few students at a table.

Attendance Policy:

- Student attendance is required during summer school. Referral is based upon failing grades and lack of credit.
- It is required that student arrives on time for class. Class will begin promptly at 8:00 AM for MATH / 8:00 AM or 11:30 AM for PLATO ONLINE class each day. **Please arrive early!** *Free Breakfast served at 7:30 AM and Lunch served at 11:00 AM.*
- Absences impact the student's ability to maintain adequate progress in this fast paced classroom instruction. Attendance is vital to the student's success. Please schedule doctor appointments for after school or on Fridays.
- **Student is allowed to miss one (1) day of class in 9 days or two (2) days maximum of duration of summer school.** Summer School runs for 18 days. Please call Summer School Office at the school site if student is absent.
- After the second day of absence the student is dropped from program and will not receive credit. If student is dropped grade will reflect "Dropped".
- **Three (3) tardies is considered one (1) day of absence. A tardy is arriving 10 minutes late. Tardy of 20 minutes or more is considered one (1) day of absence. Attendance Policy is enforced.**
- Summer School secretary will contact parent if student is tardy or absent to remind them of the Attendance Policy.

Grades/Credit:

- **It is the responsibility of parent/guardian to make certain that the class the student is registered for will be accepted for credit. Please consult with your student's counselor for verification.** Summer school is based upon referral from the school counselor and a letter should have been mailed home for recommendation. Plato Online classes are not University Admissible.
- Class participation is required, homework may be assigned in the HS MATH Program, and tests are done on a regular basis and the final grade/s will be the deciding factor in promotion or credit for the course/s. If taking two semesters in Plato On-line, student needs to complete one semester makeup in 9 days, 27 hours. Program allows 18 days or 54 hours to complete all course work.
 - ◊ If student earned a failing grade, no promotion or credit will be awarded, please contact your school. No option of refund.
 - ◊ **Final Exams will not be administered early, student must be in attendance last day of school.**
 - ◊ Final Grades will be mailed home by July 20, 2021 and sent to the school of attendance listed on form.

Conduct:

- **Due to COVID and FUSD Guidelines, all students and staff must wear an approved mask while in class, restrooms and passing in the hallways. The mask can be removed when eating breakfast or lunch in the commons area, sitting with few students at a table.** Correct use of masks is expected at all times. Both person's nose and mouth must be covered at all times. Student refusal to cooperate with the mask protocol at FUSD sites will result in the following actions below:
 - **1st Time:** The student will be reminded to wear mask properly, completely covering their nose and mouth. If the student complies and this is not a recurring incident, then no further action is needed. Disposable mask will be provided for 1st offence if student arrives at school without one.
 - **2nd Time:** The student will be redirected to the site administration. The student's parent/guardian will be contacted to pick the student up from school for the day. Student will wait in the main office until parent/guardian come to school to pick up their student. This will be considered an absence.
 - **3rd Time:** The student will no longer be allowed to attend summer school and dropped from the program as attendance is required per Attendance Policy listed above.
- Students are expected to conduct themselves as they would in regular school environment and follow FUSD Policies and Procedures. Teachers determine the behavioral expectations for students in their class. Disruptive behaviors that interfere with teaching and learning are unacceptable.
- **NO CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED DURING CLASS TIME!** 1st time warning, 2nd time parent called, 3rd time student MAY be sent home and DROPPED from program.
- **The following are consequences for disrupting the educational environment:**
 - ◊ If student needs to be removed from the classroom, parent/guardian will be called and the student will be sent home with parent/guardian. The portion of the instructional day missed will apply as a tardy.
 - ◊ If the student violates safety rules that lead to harm, injury, or damage, including bullying and intimidation, the student will be sent home and dropped from the program.
 - ◊ If the student is in possession of a weapon or item that can lead to injury or damage, a report will be made to appropriate authorities, the student will be sent home and dropped from the program.
 - ◊ If the student is in possession of tobacco, alcohol or drugs, a report will be made to the appropriate authorities, the student will be sent home and dropped from the program.
- If student is not feeling well during the school day or arrives ill, parent/guardian will be called to pick up student as soon as possible.
