
## **Welcome to Food Services**



Flagstaff Unified School District #1 offers school meals - both breakfast and lunch - for all FUSD students during the academic school year. For the 2022-2023 school year, student breakfast will cost \$1.85 at all FUSD schools and student lunch will cost \$3.20 (Elementary schools) and \$3.30 (Middle and High schools).

## **Important Update**

Food Service School Meal Program for 2022-2023.

As you are aware, schools have been able to offer breakfast and lunch at no charge to students during the 2021-2022 school year. This was made possible thanks to the generous support of the USDA reimbursing schools for meals served to students, regardless of income.

The School Breakfast Program (SBP) and the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) are federal programs. Due to changes at the federal level, we will no longer be able to offer school meals at no charge for all students during school year 2022-2023, as was the case for the 2021-2022 school year.

For the school year 2022-2023, we are requesting that families complete and submit the Free and Reduced-Price Household Application by September 1, 2022 if they believe their student(s) are eligible. payments online. Please visit www.myschoolbucks.com. There is no fee to add money to your student's account. You will need your student's "FUSD student ID number" (which you can get from the school office) in order to set up an account with My School Bucks. You will then be able to keep an eye on the account and set up regular payments. Thank you for your attention to this very important matter.
