### Knoles Parent Learning Community Information

- 6 sessions will be offered during the year
- Parents/Guardians that attend at least 3 of the 6 will receive a \$60 stipend
- Parents/Guardians that attend **more** than 3 sessions, will receive an additional \$20 for each session, earning a potential of \$120.
- The stipend is per person attending
- First come, first served basis, **capped at 25 participants** for each session
- Food & child care will be provided

Key presenters will be brought in to share their expertise on the focus for each month. The topics tie into the Knoles vision and mission, to create a safe, positive learning environment, for all children at Knoles.
