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Registration dates and times for MEMS students for the School Year 2015-2016:

8th grade	July 28, 2015	8:00-2:00
7th grade	July 29, 2015	8:00-2:00
6th grade	July 30, 2015	8:00-2:00

(If you have students in multiple grades you may register them on the same day.)

All 6th grade students will need to show up-to-date immunization records, pay a \$40.00 project fee for the year and bring in proof of residency with name and address of parent/guardian that matches the student's physical address on file (no P.O. Boxes). Any of the following will work for proof of residency: AZ driver's license, ID or vehicle registration, mortgage documents, property tax bill, water, electric, gas, cable or phone bill, bank or credit card statement, W-2 wage statement or a payroll stub.

All 7th and 8th grade students need to pay a \$40.00 project fee for the year. If you moved this year, please bring in proof of residency with name and address of parent/guardian. If you reside at the same address as last year and provided proof of residency last year you do not need to bring a new copy this year. Any of the following will work for proof of residency: AZ driver's license, ID or vehicle registration, mortgage documents, property tax bill, water, electric, gas, cable or phone bill, bank or credit card statement, W-2 wage statement or a payroll stub.
