She said that additional calculations from the State of Arizona have resulted in the need to increase the price of lunch at the elementary level to \$2.45 instead of \$2.40. She said the updated information from the State will keep the secondary lunch price at \$2.70 so an increase is not necessary.

Ms. Biggerstaff moved to approve the price increase for elementary paid lunches from \$2.30 to \$2.45 to comply with the National School Lunch Program standards. Ms. Fredericks seconded; motion carried.
